

**RELATIONS WITH COMMUNITY  
AND BUSINESS ORGANIZATIONS**

The Board of Education recognizes the potential benefits of community and business partnerships with school districts. The Board and district staff shall therefore cooperate with those organizations which may provide support in improving the educational, vocational, counseling, and/or extra-curricular opportunities in the district. The District shall maintain an ongoing dialogue with community and business leadership, both on a formal and informal basis.

Partnerships with these organizations may include mentor and/or apprenticeship programs, pilot projects, grants, off-campus counseling services, and volunteer services, in addition to or as part of the district curriculum.
