

**STUDENT WITHDRAWAL AND TRANSFER FROM SCHOOL**

**Student Withdrawal**

Only a student over the compulsory education age may be permitted to withdraw from school in accordance with Education Law 3202(1-a). No such student may be dropped from enrollment unless he or she has been absent twenty (20) consecutive school days and the school complies with further procedures established by law. Under no circumstances may students under the compulsory age be dropped from attendance rolls.

**Transferring Students**

All student transfers shall be made in accordance with New York State Regulations and School District Procedures.

The Board of Education directs the Superintendent to establish regulations and procedures to ensure compliance with this policy.
