

**FUNDRAISING, PUBLIC SOLICITATION OF STUDENTS,
AND SALES TO STUDENTS IN THE SCHOOLS**

Fundraising

Any internal fundraising activities have to be approved by the building principal and must meet the provisions of the Education Law and the Commissioner's Regulations

Public Solicitation of Students

The direct solicitation of funds from students in District schools by non-school agencies is prohibited, except as provided by law. Distribution of drive-connected materials to students by incorporated not-for-profit organizations may be done only with the prior permission of the Superintendent of Schools.

Sales to Students

Sales of goods and services (other than photographs) to students in the schools shall be permitted only when all of the following criteria are met:

1. Sales are sponsored by a student extracurricular activity.
2. Sales are approved by the Principal.
3. Sales or preparation for sales do not occur in the classroom during instructional periods.
4. Sales do not violate Education Law.
