

TRANSPORTATION FOR NONPUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS

The parent or guardian of a child residing in the District who desires the child be transported to a non-public school during the next school year must submit a written request to the Director of Transportation or his/her designee no later than April 1st preceding such next school year, or within 30 days after establishing residence in the District. No late request of a parent or guardian shall be denied where a reasonable explanation is provided for the delay. The Superintendent of Schools has the discretion to determine the reasonableness of the excuse for late requests.

Transportation is subject to the walk/ride distances established in District Policy 8411. Transportation will not be provided for students attending private schools and home-schools located outside the District limits from their home in excess of 15 miles measured by the shortest distance along public streets and roads, or less the minimum distance designated for District students.
