

FOOD SERVICES MANAGEMENT

The Board of Education recognizes that school cafeterias are a part of the total school program. The Board shall therefore provide adequate facilities, resources and personnel for the provision of food services for all elementary and secondary students in District schools. Students will be provided with a nutritionally sound food service program at a reasonable cost.

Food services shall include lunches and breakfasts through participation in the National School Lunch and Breakfast programs. School breakfast and lunch prices shall be set by the Board.

As required for participation in the National School Lunch Program, the Board agrees to the following regulations

1. Current Meal Pattern is available to all students.
2. Tax free or reduced price lunches and breakfasts be provided for students who cannot afford to pay the price of the Current Meal Pattern lunch and/or breakfast.

The sale of any food to students during the regular school day requires the prior approval of the principal and the Director of Food Services. The commercial operation of beverage or food vending machines for sale items to students during regular school hours is prohibited.
