

Registration Requirements

The Corning-Painted Post School District utilizes a school based registration process. In order to register your child or children in any Corning-Painted Post Schools, please be advised that there is a specific process to follow. You must go to the office of the school your child will attend during regular office hours from 8:00am – 4:00pm to do the registration. It is always best to call ahead to make an appointment. All students must be registered by a parent or legal guardian.

Items Needed to Register

- Parent Photo I.D. (***Photo Identification Is Required***)
- Child's Birth Certificate

ACCEPTABLE PROOFS OF RESIDENCY

- Mortgage commitment letter for a newly purchased home
- Formal lease agreement accompanied by receipt of rent
- Current homeowners insurance policy
- Current Property Tax bill for a Corning-Painted Post School District residence.
- Two Current utility bills for the household address. A combination of any (example: Gas, Electric, Water, Cable, Internet, Landline phone)
- Major credit card bill with current address
- Current bank statement
- Payroll stub
- Valid NYS driver's license with current address
- Other proofs as may be deemed appropriate at the discretion of the district.

Personal mail addressed to the resident will not be accepted as proof of residence.
